

Exam Protocols

If you have taken an oral examination, you can record your experience in an examination protocol. You will receive a reward for this as explained below. **Please send us your examination protocol with your IBAN number and your postal code to pruefungen@vmp.ethz.ch.** We will then gladly transfer the corresponding amount to you. Thank you for your work!

Evaluation Criteria

Remuneration depends on the duration of the test and the quality of the protocol. The latter is assessed by the VMP according to the criteria below. The higher amount can be achieved for 30-minute examinations of core subjects. The amount in brackets relates to the remaining subjects and 20-minute exams.

The basic criterion is that the protocol should prepare the students for the exam. It is very helpful to get information about the type of questions, the required level of detail of the answers, whether to calculate examples or rather to derive proofs, etc.

If this criterion is fulfilled and the document is made with the VMP templates in LaTeX, we will decide the financial reward based on the following criteria:

- **CHF 25 (20) Examination Sketch**

The content and history of the testing is roughly explained. However, the conversation is not reproduced in full; certain formulas and sketches may be missing, as long as it is clear what was meant - for example, if the derivation is carried out in the script.

- **CHF 50 (35) Examination Protocol**

The protocol clearly shows the course of the exam. You briefly describe the atmosphere during the exam and the form. Was the examiner benevolent, helpful? Did the exam take place on the blackboard or on paper? Was it a question of preparation or was it more of a spontaneous dialogue? You explain the last questions, your answers and the examiner's reaction. Wrong answers and their respective corrections are also helpful. The formulas and sketches used are fully contained in the report.

- **CHF 60 (40) Examination Protocol +**

For an exam protocol which exceeds the expectations, i.e. shows the course of the exam, has all the formulas and sketches, but also has additional statements or visual aids (e.g. feynman diagrams, quantum circuits, graphs), you might be eligible for a small bonus.
